Interlibrary Loan

When you need materials not held in our collection, Interlibrary Loan (ILL) can often help by getting them from other libraries.

- Books, CDs, DVDs, and other materials may be requested for pick up at Circulation or Music Library.
- Articles and book chapters may be requested for email delivery.

To use ILL, create an account in the ILLiad system and then enter requests.
